Meals are prepared to order and there is no guarantee that there will be anything spare. *The office will phone you if your child has no lunch which is an inconvenience for you.*

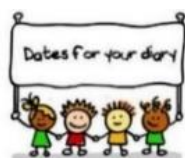


The Spring 2 wellbeing newsletter was sent home with the children this week. If you missed it you can find the full version on the school website.
