Here at Moorland, we ensure that the curriculum is accessible to all pupils.

There may be occasions, due to school closures or restrictions on attendance, where school access for pupils is restricted or in individual cases where a pupil is unable to attend school but is able to learn. In these circumstances, we will:

-  *Ensure continuity of learning and the curriculum*
-  *Ensure consistency in the approach to remote learning for all pupils (Inc. SEND) who aren't in school through use of quality online and offline resources*
-  *Provide pastoral support*
-  *Provide clear expectations to the members of the school community with regards to the delivery of high quality remote learning materials*
-  *Support effective communication between the school, families and children*
-  *Provide appropriate guidelines for data protection.*

Our remote education is delivered on the platform 'SeeSaw'.

SeeSaw provides a safe way for us to teach, share content and receive pupils completed work. It can be accessed online, through any desktop or mobile devices with Internet capabilities—including iPhone, iPad and Android devices.

All uploaded work can be accessed through individual log-ins on SeeSaw.

It is a safe and secure platform that children are familiar with as they regularly use it within the school curriculum.
