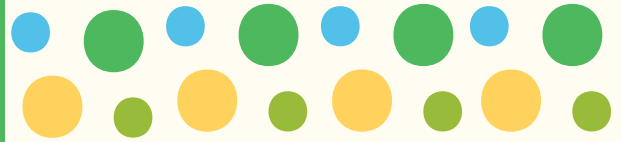

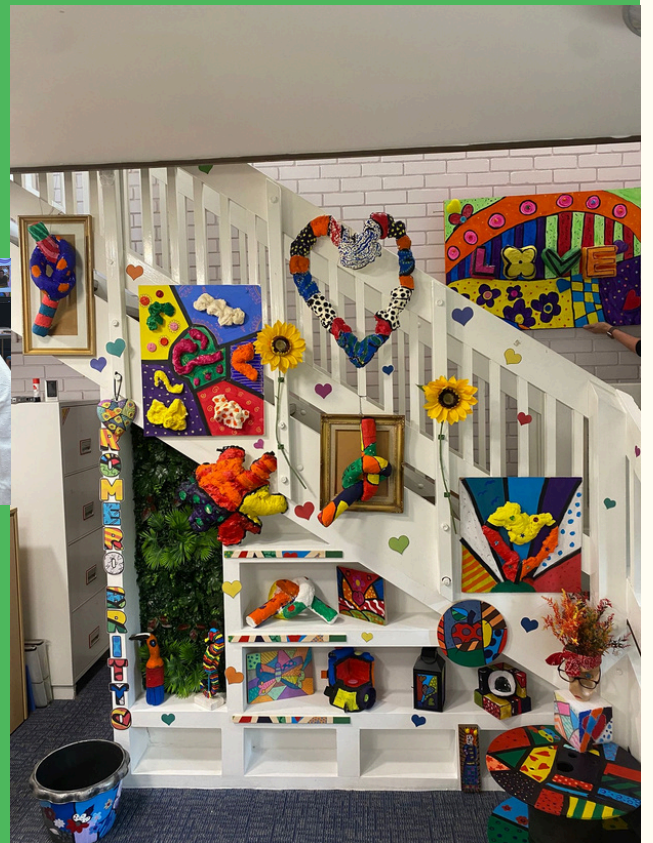
To begin our Inset day, all the staff had to create their own contributions to the brand new Moorland Gallery in the entrance of the office.

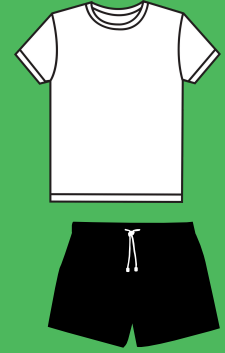

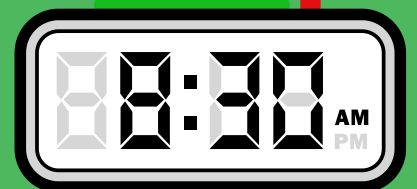
