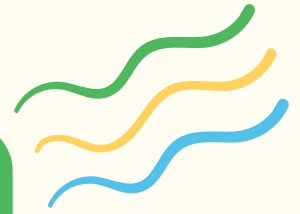
We continue to use TrackitLights as part of our behaviour system.

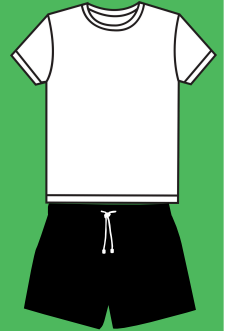

Announcement



We have been made aware of a “trend” on social media circulating at the moment called the “**Ice and salt challenge**” where children pour salt on their skin and then apply ice to the same area. This causes a burning sensation and children are challenging each other to withstand the pain for the longest amount of time.

The chemical reaction of ice with salt can cause the mixture to reduce in temperature to as low as -18oc, which creates a result similar to frostbite, often causing blistering of the skin.

Cool the affected area under lukewarm running water for at least 10 minutes.
Cover with clean cling film or smooth plastic.

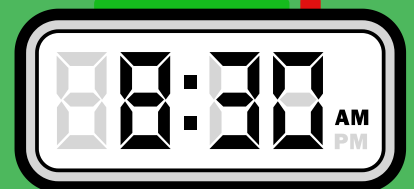
