A huge well done to the everyone at Moorland for such a strong start to the year.

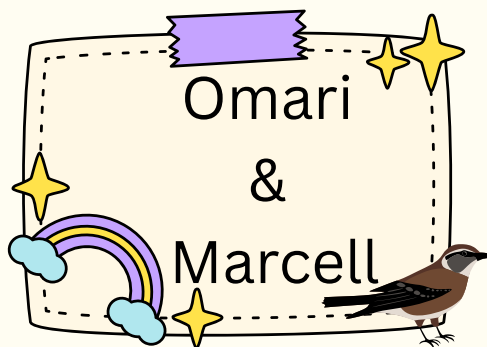
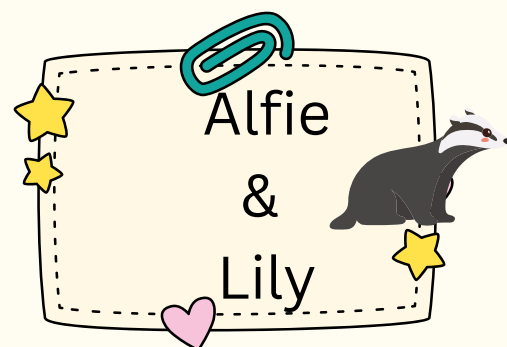
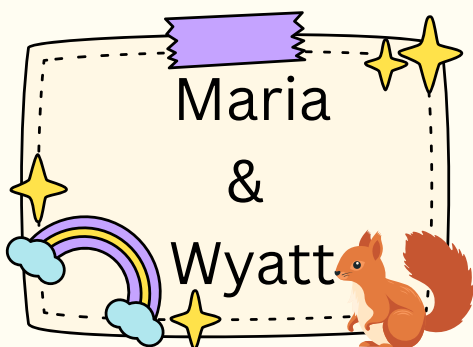
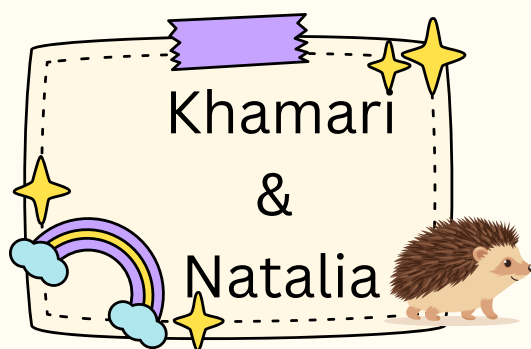


Our new School Councillors

Again, they will formally introduce themselves in their own wellbeing newsletter... so keep an eye out!

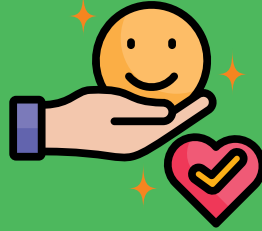
