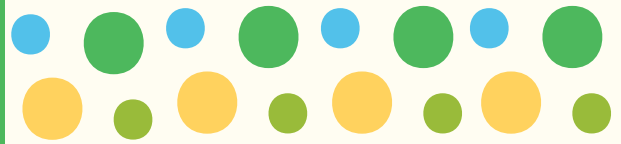

# Macmillan Coffee Morning



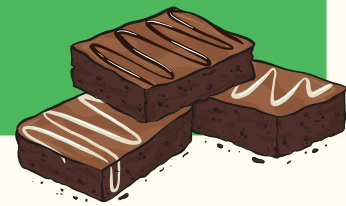
On Wednesday, we hosted our annual Macmillan coffee morning to raise money for this fabulous charity, that is close to the hearts of many of our Moorland community.

# Parent code of conduct

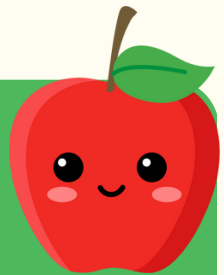
You will have received a digital copy of the new “Parent code of conduct” that has been issued across all six Campfire Education Trust schools.

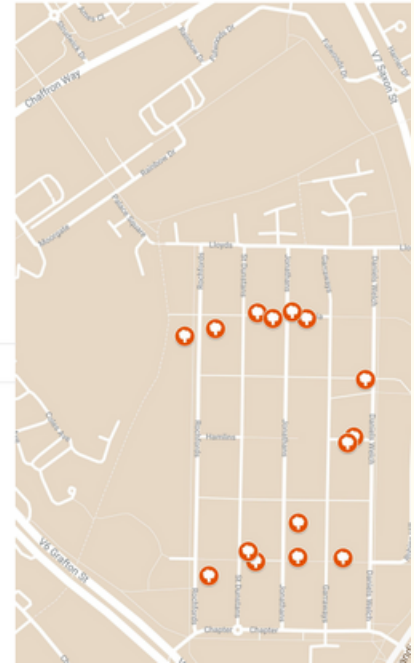
