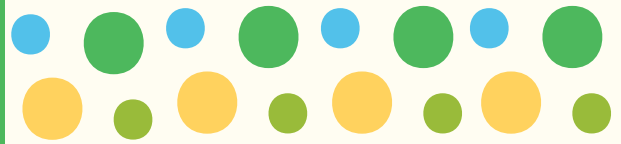

There are easy ways to monitor or control what your child has access to on their devices, including “Google Family Link” which is free, easy to download and gives you control.

You can also set up “Google Safe Search” and install “YouTube Kids” which is age restricted, unlike YouTube.

Just a reminder that YouTube, Snap chat, Instagram and TikTok all have account age limits of **13 years old**.

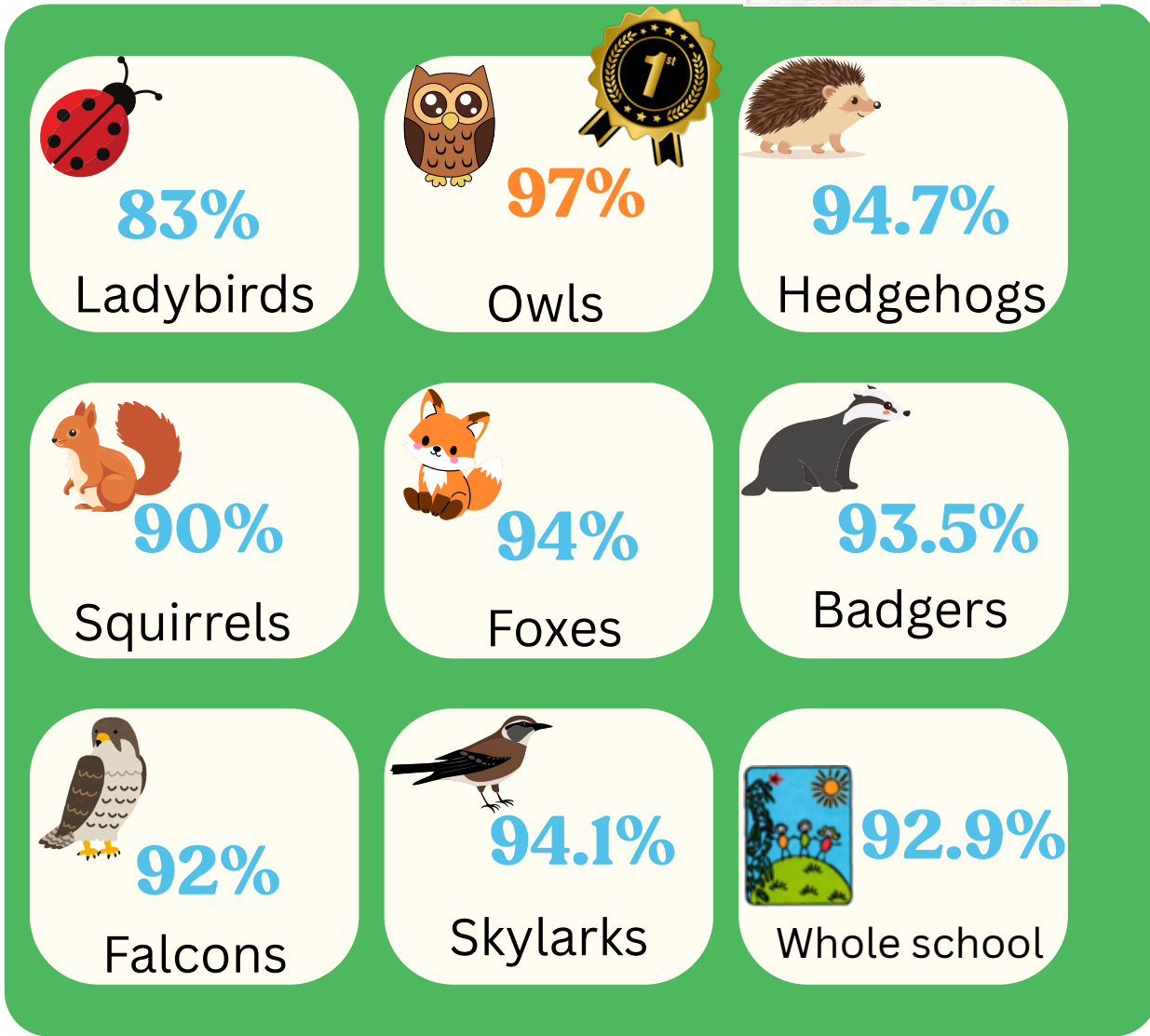
