On Monday 23rd June we will be creating our own Hobby Horses. Please could we ask that you bring in any recycling that we could use to build our equine pals before that date.



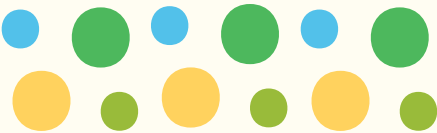
RIDE HIGH

There will be drinks and sweet treats available for children and parents.



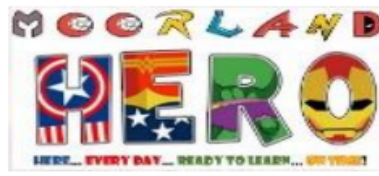
PROUD

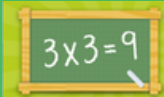
