We will all walk up to Capron Field for games & races. Then we will have a community picnic to finish the event. Everyone Welcome!

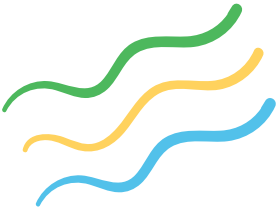

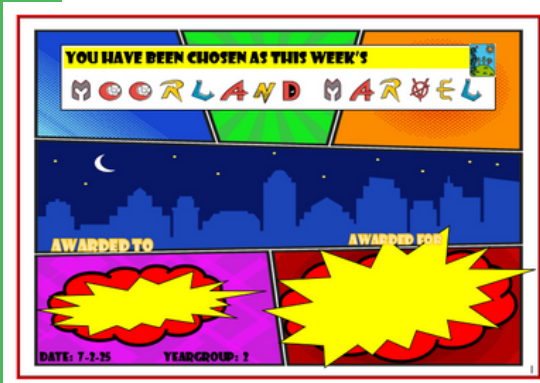

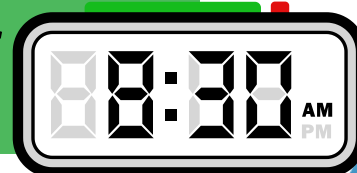
