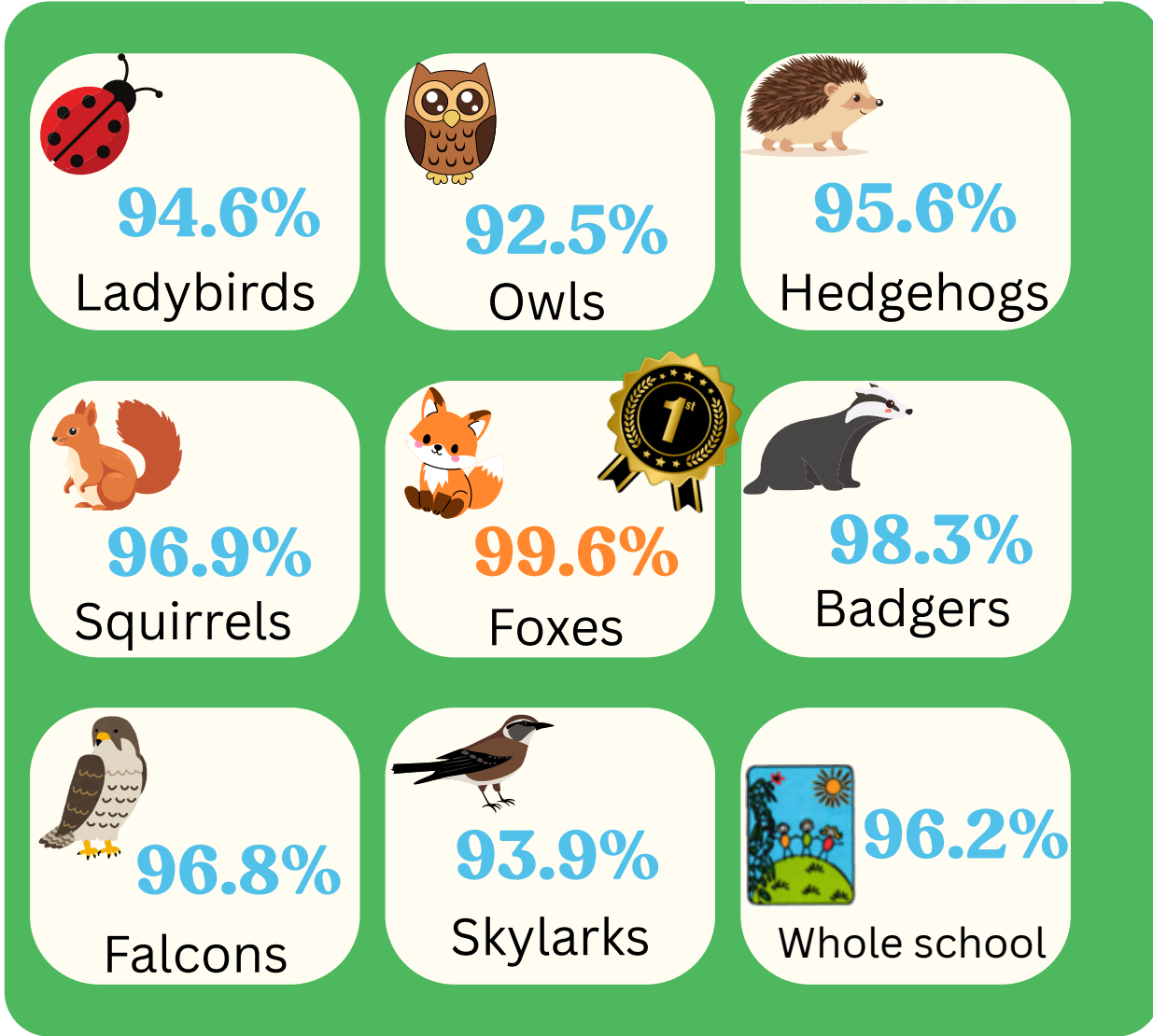

Attendance



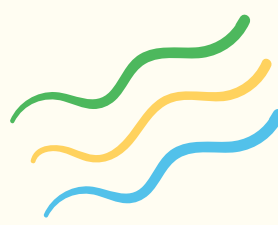
