

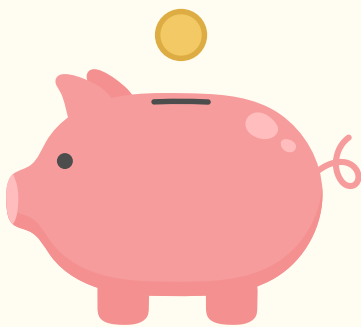
WHAT A WEEK!

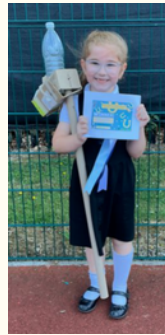

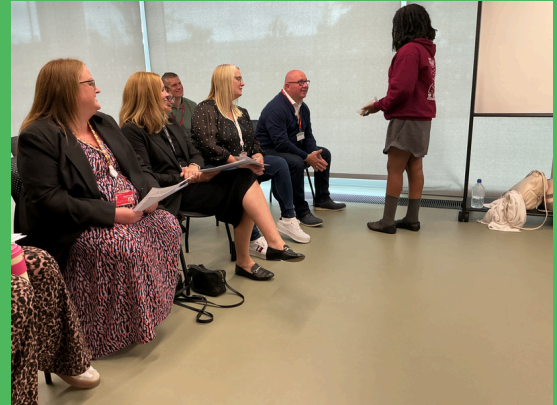

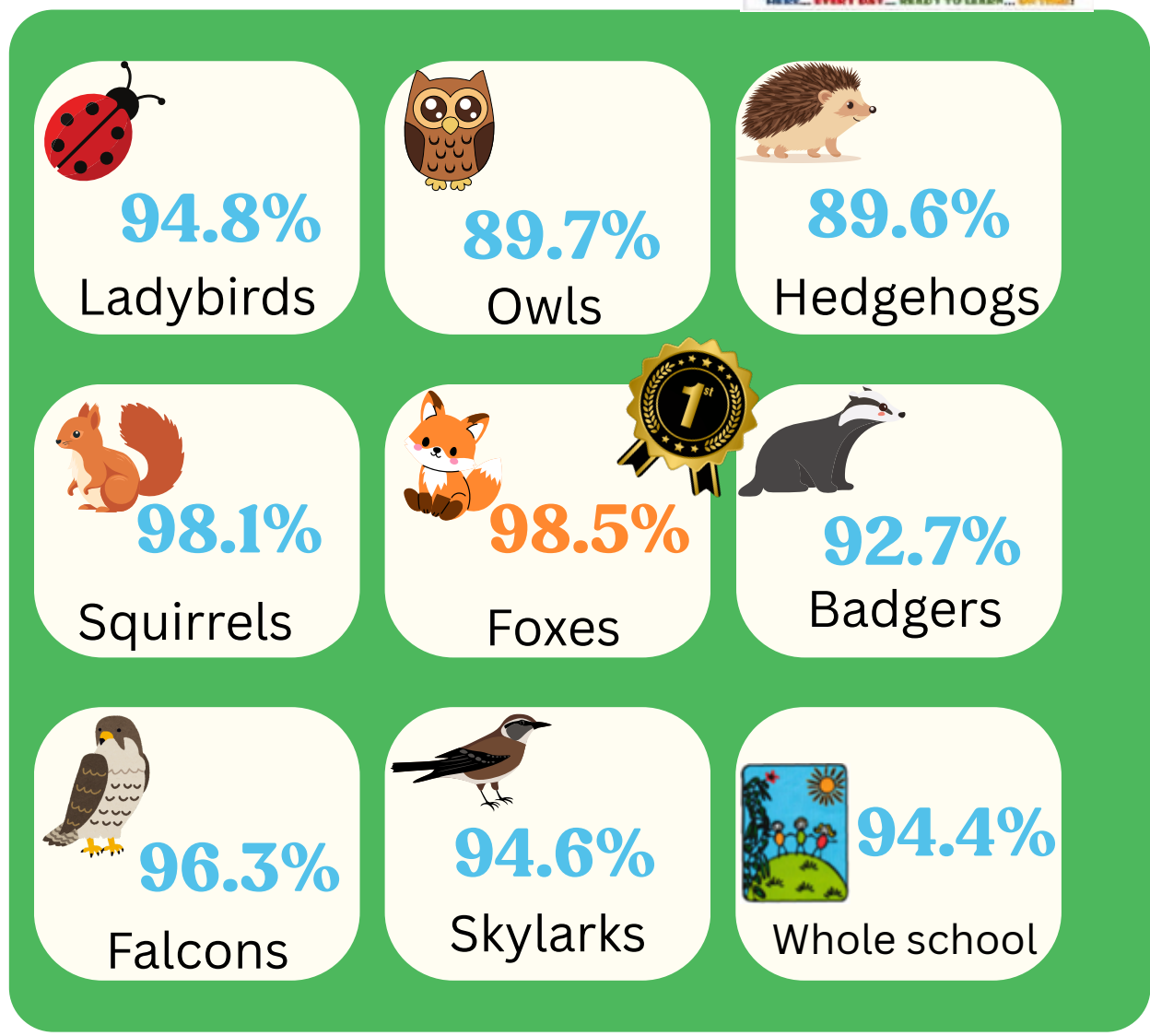
