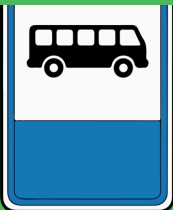

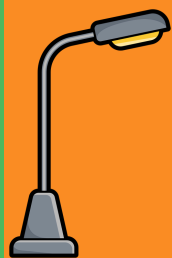

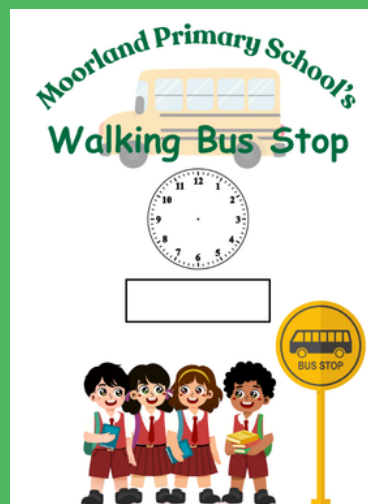

Keep an eye out for our bus stop signs along the route with times to tell you what time the walking bus arrives at each street.

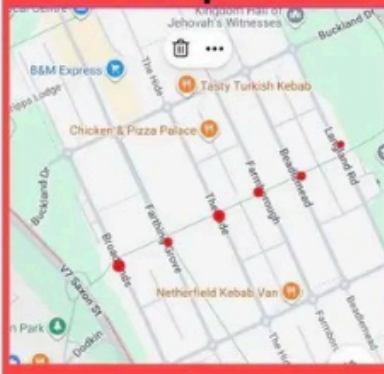


Just a reminder of the route

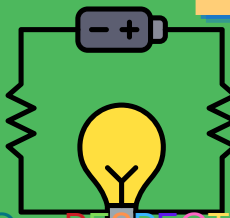

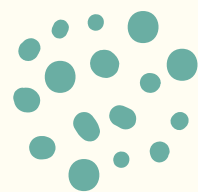
