# MOORLAND WALKING BUS!

We now have almost 20 children a day using the walking bus to get to school on time. It is such a great opportunity to chat with friends before the school day starts. Join us if you can!

The data speaks for itself:

In Autumn term, we had 17 pupils who were repeatedly late for school. In Spring term, this has reduced to 6!

The number of children who have improved their attendance this term has increased from 9 children to 15 children!

What an improvement.

But we would love to see it get even better!

The walking bus will be starting next week - Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> February. Come along and join us for a safe walk to school.

**What is the walking bus?**  
The walking bus is operated by Moorland Primary School and supported by Woughton Community Council. This is a good way for children to get into school safe and on time. The walking bus will have DBS checked adults and qualified staff to guide and support children walking to school. What better way to get to school than on a Moorland bus! there will be pick up points throughout Netherfield where you can join the bus as we pass through that stop.
