Gardening CLUB

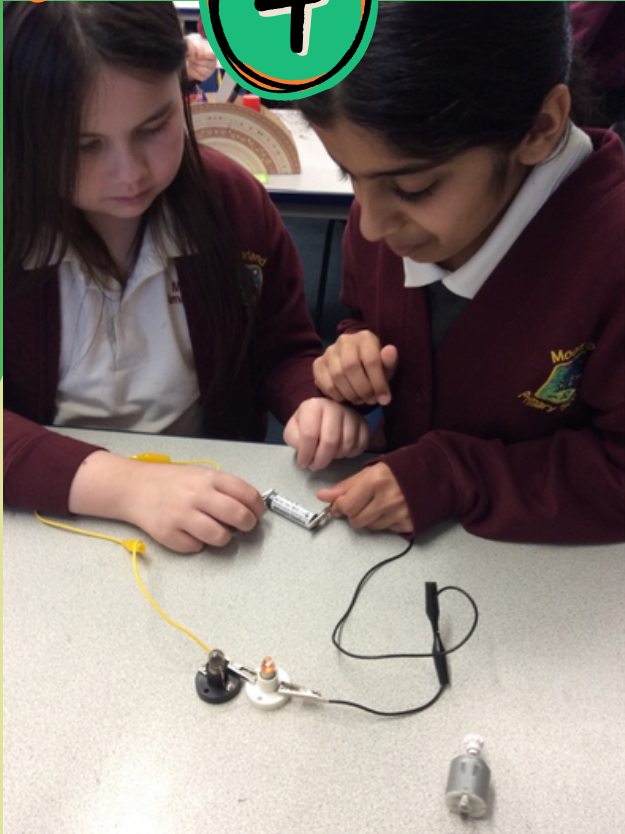
