I do not feel that bullying is dealt with effectively and parents are not informed through the process. Also feel parents are not informed of situations such as my childs teacher not being in since before half term but no explanation as to why or when she will be back

More bicycle stations close to gate

More football time at break time instead of basket ball

Something you could improve is making sure he finishes his lunch as sometimes he doesn't.

Communication with teaching staff could be stronger when using platforms such as see-saw
