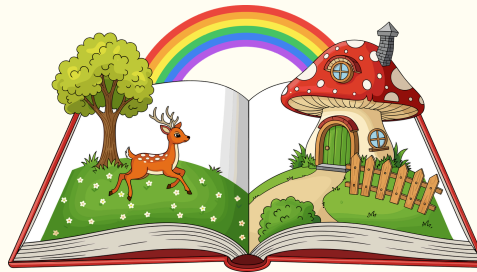
THIS WEEK AT MOORLAND

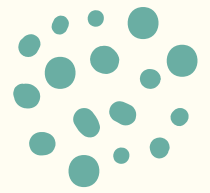

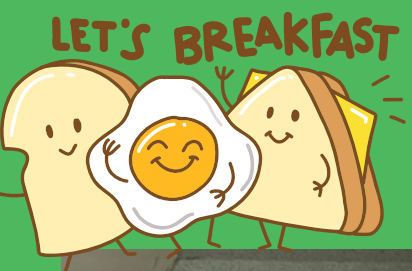

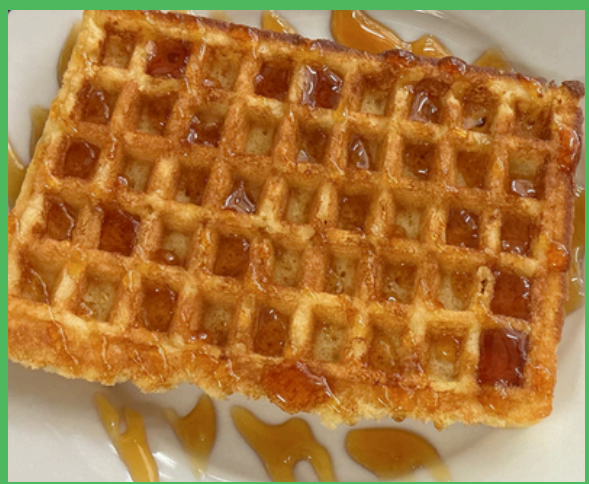
