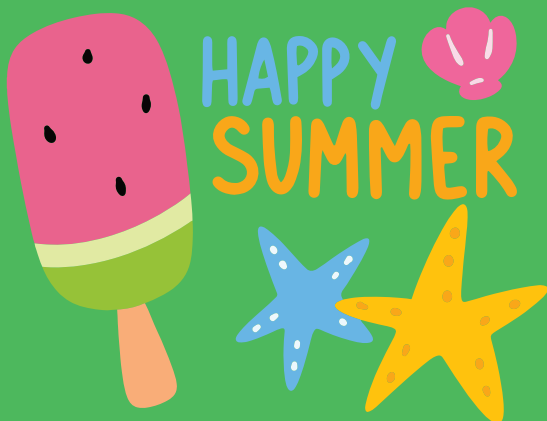
Milton Keynes City Council are funding 100's of activities across Milton Keynes over the summer holidays as part of their Holiday Fun and Food Programme.
